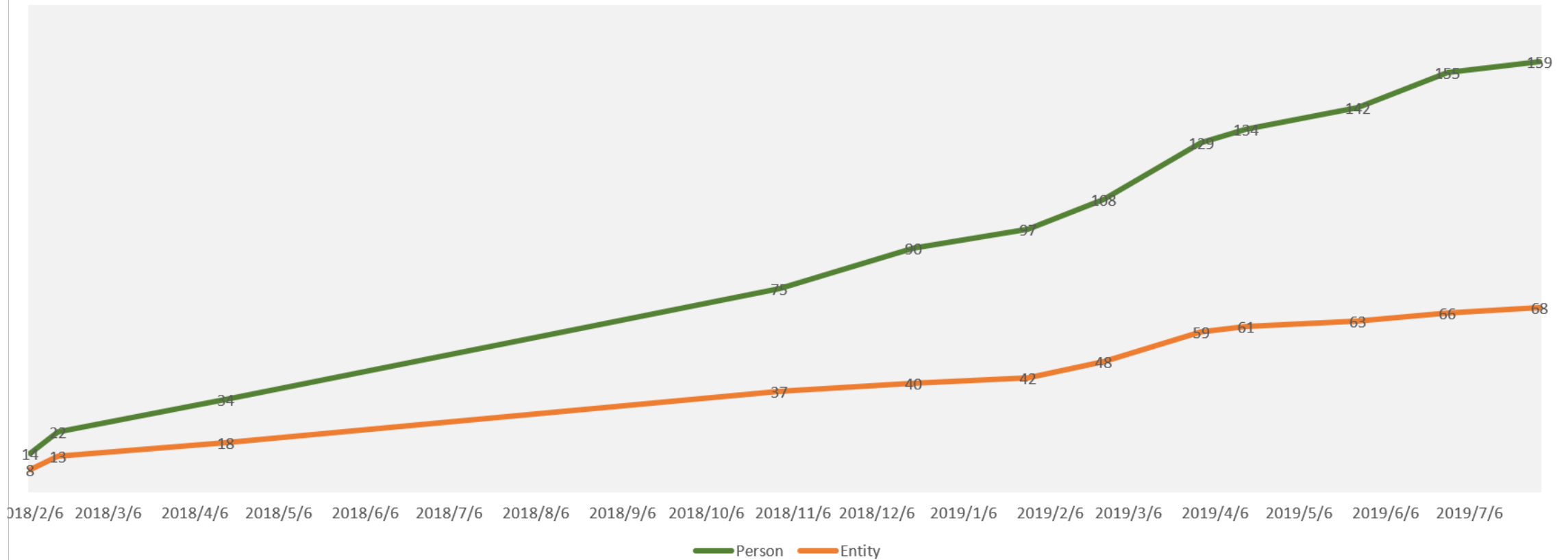

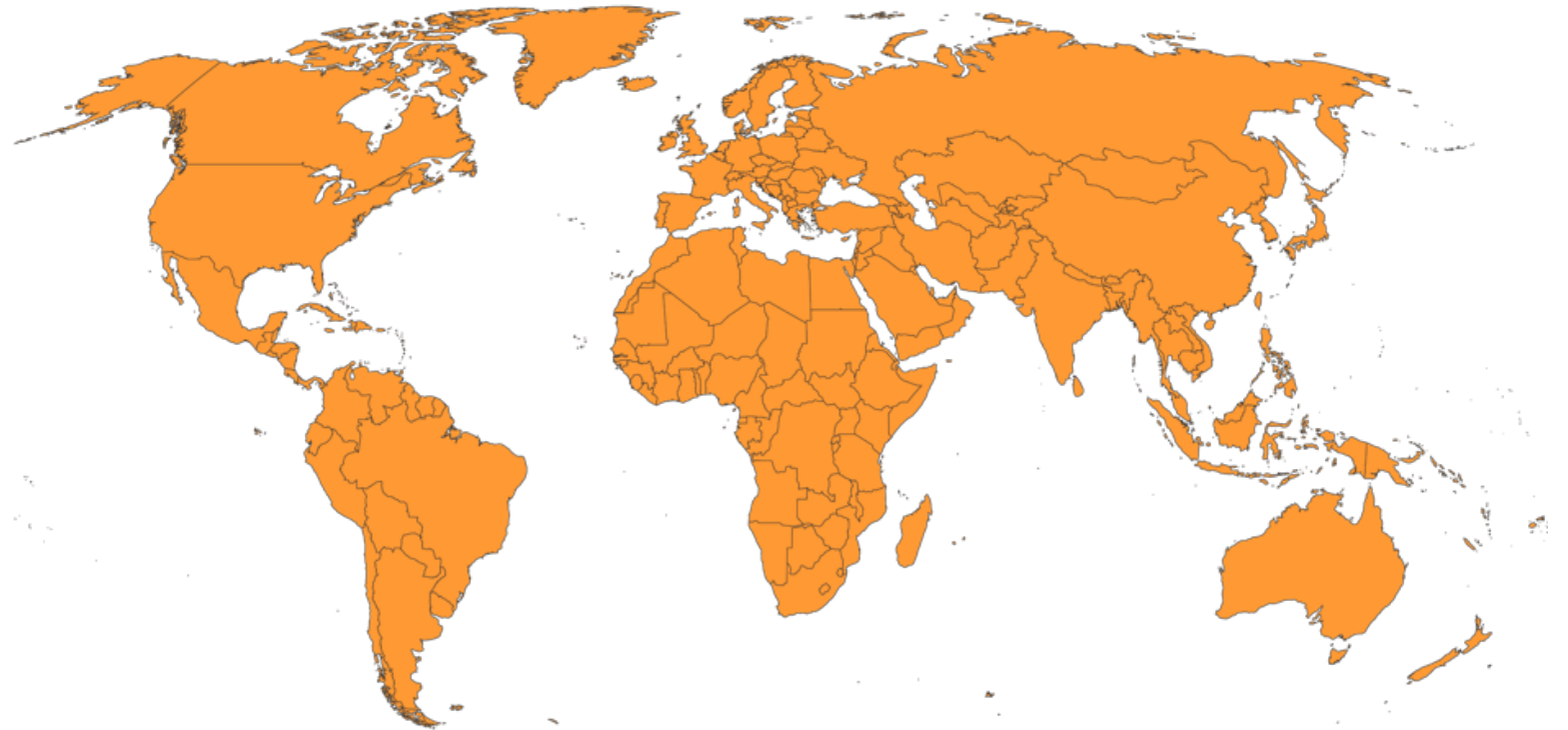

The OpenChain Project is submitting our specification to ISO via Publicly Available Specification (PAS) in Joint Technical Committee 1 (JTC-1).

Working in partnership with in partnership with Joint Development Foundation we expect to become a formal standard in the 1<sup>st</sup> half of 2020.
